How do I open my state K-12 website using Dreamweaver?

Answer:

These steps are the same for PCs and Macs.

- 1. Open **Dreamweaver**.
- 2. Click Site, and select New Site....
- 3. In the Site Name field, entered the desired name for your local website files.
- 4. In the Local Site Folder, enter the desired location and file name for your local website files.

- 7. In the Server Name field, you can enter your site name or **WebDAV** (Dreamweaver requires this field to have content but the information you enter does not impact your site connection).
- 8. In the Connect using drop-down menu, select **WebDAV**.
- 9. In the URL field, enter your site's URL (including the https:// part).
- 10. Enter your K-12 username and password.
- 11. Click the **Test** button to verify that you can connect to your site:
 - If Dreamweaver can successfully connect, you have entered your information correctly. Click **OK**.
 - If DreamWeaver cannot connect, double-check your site URL and your username and password to make sure they are correct, and test your connection again.
